ARE YOU MOVING?

An accurate count of students for each grade is very important. If you are moving to another school or district next year, please let our school office staff know as soon as possible so that we can plan for classroom sizes and staffing for the 22-23 school year.

VOLUNTEERING

Classroom(in-person or virtual) or on-campus volunteers ~

Complete a <u>background check (level 1)</u> and submit your proof of vaccination through Safe Visitor Solutions. This background check is through the Washington State Patrol System which many of you are familiar with. More information about background checks are provided in the Northshore School District Orientation.

Drivers or field trip chaperones ~

Complete a background check (level 2) and submit your proof of vaccination through Safe Visitor Solutions. There is a \$12.95 cost to the volunteer to process this background check. In some cases, additional fees may be requested to obtain information from certain jurisdictions. If this cost creates a hardship that will prevent you from volunteering your time, please email partnerships@nsd.org. After your first year of volunteering, you will be asked to complete a free Level 1 background check at your yearly renewal.
