I've attached a picture of the confidentiality expectations from the <u>Northshore School District</u> <u>Volunteer Orientation</u>.

Confidentiality

Confidentiality

- Federal law prohibits school districts from releasing student information without parent/guardian
 permission. Disclosing this information is a violation of the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of
 1974 (FERPA).
- Keep ALL student information confidential, including student names.
- All information concerning students and teachers is strictly confidential and should not be shared with others. Keep ALL student information confidential, including scholastic and health records, test scores and grades, discipline and classroom behavior, and children's character traits.
- Share concerns with appropriate school staff only—not with the child's parents or others.
- No taking images (photo, video, audio or otherwise) of students without authorization from school staff
- Volunteers are restricted from taking, using or distributing images for personal use of students at school, school sponsored events or on field trips. Student images may not be posted on any social media, sent via email or distributed using other communication channels.
- If a volunteer is taking images for school-related use, appropriate district and school procedures must be followed. If you are unsure about these procedures please contact the <u>partnerships@nsd.org</u>.

K-2 Foundational Reading

This year students in grades K-2 will be screened for indications of areas of weakness in foundational skills associated with dyslexia(phonics, phonological awareness, and phonemic awareness). Information via training and resources has been disseminated to our K-2 teachers to aid in instruction for foundational skills.

Keep in mind the dyslexia screener is not a diagnosis for dyslexia.

Listed are short descriptions of what is being piloted, most lessons are done in the class with no homework assignments.

Amira, by Houghton Mifflin (HMH). The Amira resource utilizes unique technology--artificial intelligence (AI) in its efforts to support and improve reading proficiency. The AI within Amira is designed to listen to readers read out loud, assess progress, and provide coaching and instructional lessons based on a student's performance. Teachers have recently begun their training for Amira.

Heggerty Phonemic Awareness lessons-Phonemic Awareness: This resource contains 35 weeks of lessons intended to develop phonological/phonemic awareness. Lessons are short and only take between 5-10 minutes per day to complete. These lessons are designed to support and work with any existing core curriculum.

Star/Accelerated Reader (2nd-5th Grade) - Lastly, we are piloting Star and Accelerated Reader. I have used this program over the years and it has improved independent reading practice in many of my classes. Currently, our focus group are students receiving Title and LAP services. I personally have

connected with a number of 4th and 5th grade students. It does make for a very busy office, however, I treasure this time with our students and it is worth every minute. Soon, we will be expanding this to our 3rd graders. If your child does not require Title or LAP services but is interested in connecting with me about books please have them reach out to their teacher. I will find a way to fit them into my schedule. My focus is our most struggling readers, who are making progress as I write this!

KE Choir!

We are thrilled to have our very own KE Choir, thank you to Ms. Hamilton (KMS) who has been teaching a group of 4th and 5th graders every Tuesday after school. We look forward to their virtual performance in the weeks ahead.
